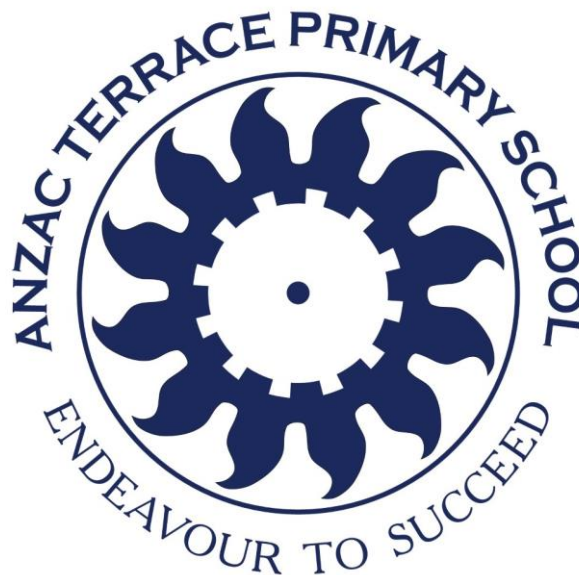

By Election Sausage Sizzle a Sell Out



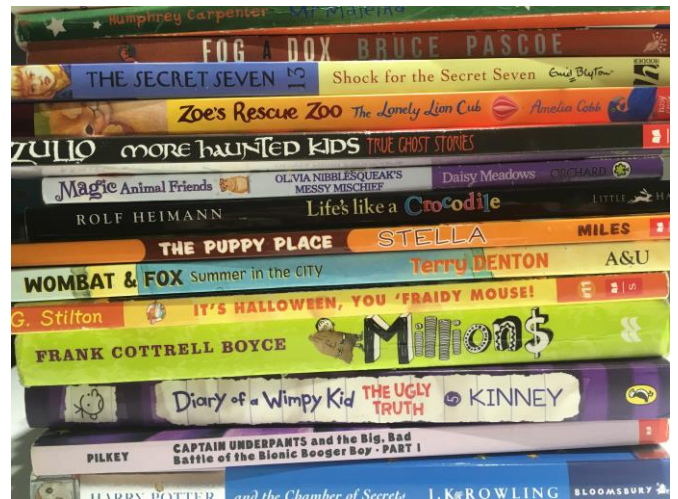
