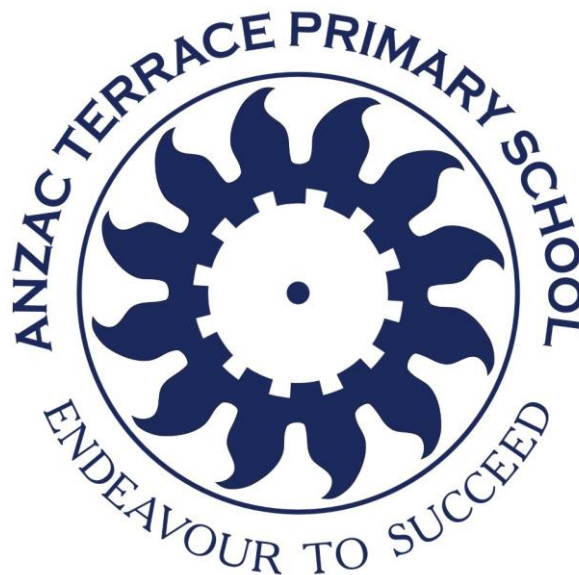

The Year in Review

In 2018 the P&C members and parent volunteers have worked extremely hard at numerous events to raise money for our school.

What did the P&C fund in 2018?

The funds we raise through P&C activities are spent on your children. This year the P&C has funded the following:

- Provided \$2050 for new chairs for the assembly area, and a trolley to move them around.
- Provided funds to purchase portable soccer goals for the senior playground.
- Spent \$8,646 to cover the gap between the grant we won (\$30,000) and the full cost of equipment and installation of the new 6m climbing net in the senior playground that was installed in August.
- Provided funds to purchase 20 iPads at \$390 each (total \$7900) for the school's Technology Program.
- Donated the \$390 raised at the Book eXchange to the library for new books and resources
- Donated \$450 towards Year 6 Graduation books and \$400 towards the end of year ECE books.
- Provided \$3668.25 to purchase a new school sound speaker system which will be installed in 2019.
- Provided funds of up to \$2150 for activities and services at next year's 50th school celebrations.
- Provided funds to create a new letterbox and entry statement for the school, due to be constructed over the summer school holidays.

Each decision to spend money is made by the P&C committee, with each member having an equal vote. Get involved to have your say.
