GREEN CARD

You can earn Green Cards in your class by doing the following things;

- 1. Following the class and school rules.
- 2. Working to the best of your ability and producing outstanding work.
- 3. Following the School Code.
- 4. Attending School regularly.

In your class you will have a class rewards system. This helps you see how well you are going. Your teacher rewards positive behaviour so that you can earn a Green Card.

What happens when you get a green card?

When you earn a green card you bring it to the office. This will be recorded on the computer against your name. Earning lots of Green Cards will get you into the GREEN CLUB.

Being a member of the GREEN CLUB gives you certain rewards and privileges.

All GREEN CLUB members will receive a badge.

4 Green Cards

Bronze Badge

8 Green Cards

Silver Badge

Lucky Dip

12 Green Cards

Gold Badge \$5 Book Voucher

16 Green Cards

\$5 Book Voucher

Platinum Badge

\$10 Book voucher

Each time a badge is earned, you will be entitled to different reward.

All GREEN CLUB members will have the opportunity to participate in a specially arranged activity at the end of the year.

Blue Cards

You may be given a **BLUE CARD** if you are not doing the RIGHT thing.

Blue Cards are given for;

- 1. Breaking your classroom rules or breaking the School Code of Conduct.
- 2. Breaking the PLAYGROUND rules.

In your class you have a set of rules which helps the class to function at its best. By following these rules you will not get in trouble and you will make the most of your learning opportunities.

In the playground we have a set of rules which helps us all to play safely and cooperatively together. By following these rules you will not get in trouble.

What happens when you get a BLUE CARD?

When you get a Blue Card you must bring it to the office. This will be recorded on the computer against your name. Receiving too many Blue Cards will mean you will have certain privileges taken from you as follows;

3 Blue Cards

20 minutes detention at lunchtime.

6 Blue Cards

Your Parents will be notified
30 minutes detention after school

Your Parents will be notified

9 Blue cards

Withdrawal from the GREEN

CLUB and you will have to start earning Green Cards again.

You will also miss the next class or school excursion / incursion.

We will need to speak to your parents.



YELLOW CARD

You may be given a **YELLOW CARD** if you do something really silly that is not SAFE and SENSIBLE.

Yellow Cards are given straight away if you;

- 1. Lose your temper and hurt someone in some way.
- 2. Play too roughly so that someone gets hurt.
- 3. Damage school property or someone else's things because you lost vour "Cool".
- 4. Say nasty things to others because you don't think.
- 5. Use inappropriate language (swearing)
- 6. Being asked too many times to do something.

The School has a set of rules that says this sort of behaviour is <u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> at our school.

Using the excuse that it was "just an accident" or "they made me do it" or "I just lost my cool" is no excuse for not thinking and behaving poorly towards others, or towards school or someone's property.

What happens when you get a YELLOW CARD?

When you get a yellow card you must go straight to the office. This will be recorded on the computer against your name. You do not get lots of chances with a yellow card. Receiving a yellow card means that certain things will happen to you <u>IMMEDIATELY</u>.

- 1. Your parents will be notified straight away.
- 2. You will lose a Green Card and have to earn it back. Losing a Green Card may mean you lose a Green Club badge.
- 3. You may miss the next school excursion or incursion.

AND / OR

4. You <u>may</u> have to do detention either in school time or after school, depending on the seriousness and result of your actions.



RED CARD



You may be given a RED CARD if you <u>DELIBERATELY</u> do something that affects or hurts other people, or causes damage around the school.

RED CARDS are given straight away if you;

- 7. Deliberately hit someone or hurt them in some way.
- 8. Deliberately verbally abuse someone. (This includes swearing, teasing and bullying)
- 9. Steal or deliberately damage school property or someone else's things.
- 10. Are deliberately disobedient.

The School has a set of rules that says this sort of behaviour is <u>NOT</u> ACCEPTABLE at our school.

Using the excuse that you just got angry is no excuse for behaving poorly towards others.

What happens when you get a **RED CARD?**

When you get a red card you must go straight to the office. This will be recorded on the computer against your name. You do not get lots of chances with a red card. Receiving a red card means that certain things will happen to you <u>IMMEDIATELY</u>.

- 5. Your parents will be notified straight away.
- 6. You will be taken out of the GREEN CLUB and have to start again.
- 7. You will miss a school excursion or incursion.
- 8. You <u>may</u> be withdrawn from class and have to do "In School Suspension"
- 9. You <u>may</u> even be suspended from school. <u>This is a serious consequence.</u>

BLACK CARD

You may be given a Black Card if when out in the Playground the Duty Teacher reprimands you for the same thing on the same day. It means you haven't learnt from your initial reprimand. You will be sent to the Deputies' Office for the remainder of the break. Black Cards are not entered on the behaviour system.
