



# Corporal Samantha Luck

Corporal Samantha Luck is a military working dog handler with the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF), she is highly specialized and primarily

known for her leadership role in the canine breeding program. Her key events include:

In March 2015, Corporal Samantha Luck became the first female to conduct Aircraft Security Operations in the middle east

In 2015, she served as a handler in the canine breeding section at RAAF Base Amberley. She has lately been responsible for overseeing the bloodlines of about 80 pups born annually at Amberley, making sure they meet the genetic and temperament standards for the RAAF base Amberley.

In 2015, she participated in community events at the base, such as hosting children from the charity Canteen for "Bandanna Day".

In 2017, Samantha Luck was reported patrolling the flight line at RAAF Base Amberley with her military working dog, Caden, as part of the RAAF Security and Fire.

Her primary operational partner has been MWD Caden, a Belgian Malinois. This breed is often preferred by the RAAF for its speed and high intelligence compared to traditional German Shepherds.
